

PATIENT INFORMATION CARDS

HOW TO COMPLETE A CARD

25th November 2021

Patient Information Cards are important because they provide the patient details on the implantable device that they have received. This information can help in times where there is an emergency situation, special care is required or if there is an incident regarding the device.

PATIENT'S DATA

- Implant Date
- Patient's information (i.e. Name or ID)

HOSPITAL'S NAME AND ADDRESS

- The hospital and address where the procedure was performed

MEDICAL DEVICE DETAILS

If you have patient labels available, you can adhere it to this panel for each device implanted.

If patient labels are unavailable, record the following:

MD Name of the Device

SN Article Code

UDI UDI Number

LOT Lot Number

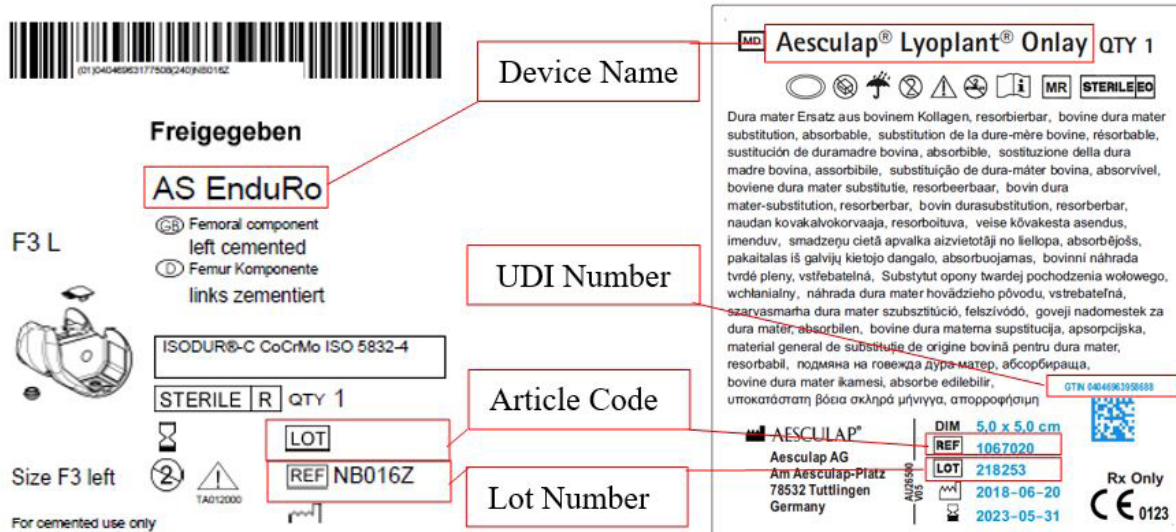


Figure 1 - Medical Device Details on Labelling

Refer to Figure 1 which highlights the required medical device details on the labelling.

Please note: UDI Numbers are not included on all B. Braun products.

GIVING THE CARD TO THE PATIENT

Once the card has been filled in with the required information, inform the patient to always carry the card with them and keep it in a safe place.

Let the patient know to inform you immediately if they have lost their patient information card.
